Beginning at the East corner of this lot and the East corner of Lot 30 and on the West side of a 25 foot road, the approximate co-ordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kaipohaku" being 1693.0 feet North and 2146.0 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 1877, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 19° 56' 391.6 feet along road;
2. 21° 10' 404.8 feet along road;
3. 73° 13' 735.3 feet along Lot 28 to a + on stone known as "Kua-hiku" Trig. Station on top of Napuu Ridge;
4. 167° 19' 157.0 feet along ridge and boundary of Puuwaawaa;
5. 166° 27' 630.0 feet along ridge and boundary of Puuwaawaa;
6. 171° 51' 167.0 feet along ridge and boundary of Puuwaawaa;
7. 268° 36' 1193.2 feet along Lot 30 to the point of beginning.
