1. 331° 40' 1560.0 feet along 50 foot road reserve;
2. 7° 00' 665.0 feet along 50 foot road reserve;
3. 312° 10' 209.0 feet along 50 foot road reserve;
4. 355° 30' 198.0 feet along 50 foot road reserve to a Δ marked on bed rock at top of falls in Kapili Stream;
5. Up center of Kapili Stream along Lot 6, the direct azimuth and distance being: 48° 15' 1092.0 feet to point in stream;
6. 173° 03' 942.0 feet up bank of said stream and along Grant 4178 to C.E. Steel;
7. 104° 26' 1527.0 feet along Grant 4178 to C.E. Steel to gully;
8. Down center of gully along Grant 4147 to Antonio C. Moniz, the direct azimuth and distance being: 226° 37' 980.0 feet;
9. Continuing down center of gully along Grant 4146 to F. Lincente the direct azimuth and distance being: 236° 10' 830.0 feet;
10. 180° 21' 465.0 feet along gully along Grant 4146 to F. Lincente to a point in gully;
11. 224° 20' 247.0 feet along Grant 4146 to F. Lincente to the point of beginning.

Beginning at an olive tree marked \triangle at the foot of which is set a 12" wrought iron tube, said olive being S 42° 52' N - true dist. 3032 ft. from the Heiau Govt Survey Reference pt "WeloKa" the boundary runs by true bearings

1 - S 80° 26' E - ^{127.11} ~~780~~ ft. down bank of Kapehu stream to middle of same

2 - S 52° 54' N - 2510 . along middle of Kapehu stream to \triangle marked on rock in same,

3 - N 57° 59' W - 1170 . along Govt forest enclosure,

4 - N 62° 22' W - 385 . along same to post marked R, set in at least edge of road,

5 - N 53° 47' E - 2395 . along East edge of road 40 ft wide separating this section from section 3, to North angle,

6 - S 63° 01' E - 1451 . along lower edge of woods to the pt of beginning
