Beginning at a galvanized iron spike at the North corner of this piece and the East corner of Lot 4, on the Southwest side of Aalapuna Avenue, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 3750.7 feet North and 10239.6 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2383, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $287^{\circ} 24' 30''$ 150.0 feet along the Southwest side of Aalapuna Avenue to a spike and pile of stones;
2. $17^{\circ} 24' 30''$ 100.0 feet along Lot 2, to a spike and pile of stones;
3. $107^{\circ} 24' 30''$ 150.0 feet along Lots 6 and 7, to a spike and pile of stones;
4. $197^{\circ} 24' 30''$ 100.0 feet along Lot 4, to the point of beginning.
