KIOLAKAA-KEAA HOMESTEAD LOTS.

KAU, HAWAII.

Lot 3.

Beginning at triangle mark on small rock and ahu on top of Hale-umiumi hill, at a point whose coordinates referred to Akihi Trig. Station are 4284.4 feet S. and 14425.5 feet E. and from which Puu-o-Lokuana Trig. Station bears S 73° 00' W true, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2176, and running as follows by true bearings; all points being marked by a + on stone and ahu, unless otherwise described:-

1. S 60° 50' W 1098 feet along Lot 2 to + on rock and ahu;
2. N 53° 28' W 251 feet along reservation for 40 foot road;
3. N 4° 27' E 444 feet along the same to + on rock and ahu;
4. N 33° 36' E 425 feet along the same to + on face of rock and ahu;
5. N 22° 42' E 258 feet along the same;
6. N 32° 13' W 219 feet along the same;
7. N 24° 5' W 197 feet along the same to + on pahoehoe and ahu;
8. N 5° 00' W 592 feet along Governemt reservation to + on pahoehoe and ahu;
9. N 19° 00' E 829 feet along reservation for 40 foot road;
10. N 17° 43' E 279 feet along the same to + on pahoehoe and ahu;
11. N 16° 48' E 117 feet along the same;
12. N 82° 17' E 2921 feet along Forest Reserve to Puu-Lepo in the woods

at a point whose coordinates referred to Akihi Trig. Station are 1118 feet S. and ¹⁶⁶⁶⁰~~1660~~ feet E.;

13. S 18° 57' E 1912 feet along Waiohinu to a small hillock 60 feet makai of a trail;

14. S 64° 38' W 3167 feet along Lot 2 to the initial point and containing an area of 209-3/10 Acres.
