Beginning at a stake at the Northwest corner of this lot on the South side of a 40 foot road, the coordinates of said stake referred to Reference Point "Kalaepohaku" (marked by a + on a rock) on the boundary of Pulehunui and Waiakoa being 1754.4 feet South and 956.4 feet East and said "Kalaepohaku" is 17875.5 feet North and 25734.0 feet West of Government Survey Trig. Station "Puu o Kali", as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2416 and running by true azimuths;-

1. 260° 34' 467.3 feet along 40 foot road;
2. 244° 16' 573.0 feet along 40 foot road;
3. 285° 15' 732.0 feet along 40 foot road to intersection of road;
4. 337° 10' 344.0 feet along 40 foot road;
5. 67° 21' 1772.0 feet along Lot 4;
6. 162° 00' 133.8 feet along beach reservation;
7. 171° 32' 152.0 feet along beach reservation;
8. 171° 25' 171.0 feet along beach reservation;
9. 167° 36' 430.0 feet along beach reservation to the point of beginning.
