Beginning at a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe at the West corner of this lot, and the East corner of Camp Road and a 30 Foot Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kalantai" being 8665.2 feet North and 1694.1 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2586, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $211^{\circ} 00'$ 1423.8 feet along Southeast side of 30 Foot Road, and along Lot 4 to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
2. $301^{\circ} 00'$ 68.0 feet along Government Reserve to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe;
3. $211^{\circ} 00'$ 120.0 feet along Government Reserve to Trig. Sta. "Palikai", marked by a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
4. $302^{\circ} 04'$ 486.4 feet along Government Reserve to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
5. $31^{\circ} 00'$ 1369.4 feet along Lot 2 to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
6. $111^{\circ} 00'$ 401.0 feet along Camp Road to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
7. $90^{\circ} 00'$ 186.0 feet along Camp Road to the point of beginning.
