Station "Kauku" being ^{21348.4}~~21340.7~~ feet North and ^{8813.6}~~8823.7~~ feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. ²⁵⁷⁴~~2382~~, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 327° 08' 975.0 feet along Lot 2 to an iron rail;
2. 56° 55' 533.0 feet along Lot 10 to an iron rail;
3. 146° 55' 938.0 feet along Lot 4 to an iron rail on the South side of Mountain Road;
4. 232° 59' 538.0 feet along Mountain Road to the point of beginning.
