Beginning at a post at the Northeast corner of this lot and the Southeast corner of Lot 29, at an angle in the West ^{side} ~~line~~ of a 30 foot road, the coordinates of said post referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Aku" being 327.9 feet South and 834.3 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2479, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 331° 13' 428.0 feet along West side of 30 foot road to a + on set stone;
2. 340° 29' 197.4 feet along West side of 30 foot road to a + on set stone;
3. 349° 44' 777.5 feet along West side of 30 foot road to a + on set stone;
4. 15° 33' 233.5 feet along West side of 30 foot road to post;
5. 90° 00' 1584.2 feet along Lot 42 to a post on the boundary of the land of Pakini-iki;
6. 219° 41' 1471.7 feet along the land of Pakini-iki to a + on set stone and ahu;
7. 171° 57' 422.7 feet along the land of Pakini-iki to a post;
8. 270° 00' 355.7 feet along Lot 29 to the point of beginning.
