Beginning at a 2 inch galvanized iron pipe at the Northeast corner of this lot, the Northwest corner of Lot 4 and on the South side of a 40 foot road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Alala" being 1856.1 feet South and 810.8 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2497, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 90° 51' 374.2 feet along road to a 2 inch galvanized iron pipe;
2. 68° 03' 150.0 feet along road to a 2 inch galvanized iron pipe;
3. 360° 00' 1309.7 feet along Lot 2 to top of pali near the edge of the Waiaama Gulch;
4. Thence Easterly along the top of the pali near the edge of the Waiaama Gulch, the direct azimuth and distance being 255° 55' 529.2 feet;
5. 180° 00' 1231.4 feet along Lot 4 to the point of beginning.
