Beginning at the East corner of this lot at a point on the mauka side of the cross road adjoining Grant 2741 to Kalaaualoha and Kaainani, the coordinates of which point being: 862.7 feet South and 558.3 feet North of the Government Survey Trig. Station "Honohina", as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2381, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 50° 00' 456.4 feet along Grant 2741 to Kalaaualoha and Kaainani
2. 334° 30' 485.0 feet along Grant 2741 to Kalaaualoha and Kaainani to a post in the Awapuhi Gulch on the bank of the stream;
3. 359° 00' 206.0 feet along stream along No. 6;
4. Along Awapuhi Stream along Lot 6, the direct azimuth and distance being: 70° 21' 951.5 feet to \triangle on boulder;
5. 133° 00' 777.0 feet along Lot 5 to road reserve;
6. 223° 00' 1424.8 feet along road reserve;
7. 278° 17' 287.7 feet along road reserve;
8. 248° 32' 120.0 feet along road reserve to cross road;
9. 323° 20' 395.8 feet along cross road reserve to the point of beginning.
