Beginning at a 2 inch galvanized iron pipe at the east corner of this lot, the S O U T H corner of Lot 4, and on the North side of the Kahuku-Piha 40 foot road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Haiku" being 8223.2 feet South and 6220.1 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map NO. 2568, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $44^{\circ} 33'$ 737.1 feet along the Kahuku-Piha 40 foot road to a pipe;
2. $135^{\circ} 20'$ 1191.2 feet along Lot 2 to a pipe on top of the South edge of Waikaumalu Gulch;
3. Thence along the top of the South edge of Waikaumalu Gulch to a pipe, the direct azimuth and distance being $247^{\circ} 51'$ 801.7 feet;
4. $315^{\circ} 34'$ 873.7 feet along Lot 4 to the point of beginning.

Area 16-73/100 Acres.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom the Stream and all riparian and other rights in or to this stream and the waters thereof.
