4. 184° 11' 156.5 feet along L.C.A. 6723:1 to Walaiula to a guava post;
5. 50° 23' 330.0 feet along L.C.A. 6723:1 to Walaiula to a guava post;
6. 139° 45' 60.0 feet along Lot 3 to a guava post;
7. 237° 30' 340.0 feet along Lots 3 and 5 to a guava post;
8. 282° 50' 55.0 feet along Lot 5 to a guava post;
9. 286° 56' 134.0 feet along Lot 2A to a guava post;
10. 10° 03' 260.2 feet along stream to the initial point.
