Beginning at a pipe at the East corner of Lot 4, the South corner of Lot 5, and on the North side of the Kahuku-Piha 40 Foot Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Haiku," being 7570.5 feet South and 5130.4 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2568, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 82° 00' 116.3 feet along the Kahuku-Piha Road;
2. 63° 53' 770.1 feet along the Kahuku-Piha Road;
3. 42° 00' 156.8 feet along the Kahuku-Piha Road to a pipe;
4. 44° 33' 991.3 feet along the Kahuku-Piha Road to a pipe;
5. 135° 20' 1191.2 feet along Lot 2 to a pipe on top of the South edge of the Waikaumalo Gulch;
6. Thence along the top of the South edge of the Waikaumalo Gulch to a pipe, the direct azimuth and distance being: 247° 51' 801.7 feet;
7. Thence still along the top of the South edge of the Waikaumalo Gulch to a pipe, the direct azimuth and distance being: 249° 35' 1350.4 feet;
8. 315° 25' 30" 620.9 feet along Lot 5 to the point of beginning

Area 33-67/100 Acres.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom the Kalaeha Stream and all riparian rights in and to this stream and the waters thereof.
