KIOLAKAA-KEAA HOMESTEAD LOTS.

KAU, HAWAII.

Lot 4.

Beginning at triangle mark on solid rock and ahu in woods at Kaiuwai at a point from which Puu-o-Lokuana Trig. Station is S $59^{\circ} 34-1/2'$ W true, 13870 feet and whose coordinates referred to Akihi Trig. Station are 1806. feet S. and 11523 feet E, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2176, and running as follows by true bearings; all points being marked by + on stone and ahu, unless otherwise described:-

1. N $82^{\circ} 32'$ E 2219 feet along Forest Reserve to + on pahoehoe and ahu;
2. S $16^{\circ} 48'$ W 99 feet along reservation for 40 foot road to + on pahoehoe and ahu;
3. S $17^{\circ} 43'$ W 278 feet along the same to + on pahoehoe and ahu;
4. S $19^{\circ} 00'$ W 821 feet along the same;
5. S $43^{\circ} 10'$ W 266 feet along the same to + on pahoehoe and ahu;
6. S $4^{\circ} 20'$ E 244 feet along the same to + on pahoehoe and ahu;
7. S $73^{\circ} 7'$ W 4528 feet along Lot 5 to the N.E. corner of Grant 3635, Kealohaai;
8. N $10^{\circ} 19'$ W 2230 feet along Lot 8 to a point between two small knolls at Kaniu;
9. N $89^{\circ} 33'$ E 1312 feet along Forest Reserve to triangle mark on solid rock and ahu on Ohialele hill;

10. N 77° 8' E 1800 feet along the same to the initial point and containing an area of 199-6/10 Acres.
