Beginning at an iron rail at the West corner of this lot, the North corner of Lot 5 and on the South side of Mountain Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kauku" being ^{20756.6}~~20748.9~~ feet North and ^{8037.8}~~8048.5~~ feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. ²⁵⁷⁴~~2382~~, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 227° 00' 53.0 feet along Mountain Road to an iron rail;
2. 232° 59' 385.0 feet along Mountain Road to an iron rail;
3. 326° 55' 1080.0 feet along Lots 3 and 10 to an iron rail;
4. 56° 55' 440.0 feet along Lot 11 to an iron rail;
5. 147° 04' 1043.1 feet along Lot 5 to the point of beginning.

Area 10-70/100 Acres.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom a right-of-way 10 feet wide across this lot for the flume, said right-of-way containing an area of 10/100 acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 10-60/100 ACRES.
