1. 321° 25' 413.0 feet along homestead road to a red-wood post;
2. 44° 25' 118.0 feet along homestead road to a red-wood post;
3. 279° 45' 153.5 feet along homestead road to a red-wood post;
4. 316° 50' 75.0 feet along homestead road to a pipe;
5. 265° 15' 624.0 feet along the land of Papaikou to a pipe;
6. 167° 30' 411.0 feet along Lot 3 to Trig. Station "Kaapoko";
7. 140° 47' 178.4 feet along Lot 3 to a pipe;
8. 82° 35' 803.5 feet along homestead road to the point of beginning.
