Beginning at a post at the Northeast corner of this lot and the Northwest corner of Lot 3 on the South side of homestead road, the coordinates of said post referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Pahiha" being: 2048.4 feet North and 1365.3 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2498, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 358° 23' 1337.15 feet along Lot 3 and across a small stream to a post, the same being 10 feet from the edge of ~~the~~ stream;
2. Westerly on a line parallel to and 10 feet from the edge of the stream to a post, the direct azimuth and distance being: 95° 36' 457.0 feet;
3. 178° 23' 1086.75 feet along Lot 5 across a small stream to a post on South side of homestead road;
4. 231° 20' 330.0 feet along South side of homestead road to a post;
5. 270° 07' 190.0 feet along South side of homestead road to the point of beginning.
