Beginning at a 2-1/2 inch galvanized iron pipe at the North corner of this lot, the West corner of Lot 3 and on the Southeast side of a 30 foot Homestead Road, the co-ordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Manowaiopae 3" being 920.5 feet South and 128.4 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2555, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 298° 35' 402.4 feet along Lot 3 to a 2-1/2 inch galvanized iron pipe;
2. 41° 06' 170.0 feet along near the edge of Hokuwaikahe Gulch to a 2-1/2 inch galvanized iron pipe;
3. 118° 35' 444.9 feet along Lot 5 to a 2-1/2 inch galvanized iron pipe;
4. 245° 00' 92.9 feet along Homestead Road;
5. 223° 17' 94.1 feet along Homestead Road to the point of beginning.

Area ~~68,600~~ ^{68,650} Square Feet.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 15 feet wide for a proposed flume over this lot which said flume will be parallel to the Southeast boundary of said lot (area 2550 Square Feet).
