Beginning at an iron stake on the edge of a small gulch adjoining Grant 3059 to Hooe and Pohukoa, the coordinates of which point are 192.5 feet South and 131.5 feet West of the Government Survey Trig. Station "Honohina", as shown on Government Survey Registered Map 2381, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 316° 12' 493.0 feet along Grant 3059 to Hooe and Pohukoa;
2. 98° 17' 300.0 feet along road reserve;
3. 43° 00' 1600 feet along road reserve;
4. 98° 43' 101.6 feet along road reserve;
5. 67° 06' 149.5 feet along road reserve;
6. 336° 26' 157.0 feet along road reserve;
7. 56° 17' 953.0 feet along road reserve;
8. 27° 31' 736.1 feet along road reserve to 40 foot road reserve;
9. 126° 30' 403.0 feet along 40 foot road to the center of a small gulch;
10. Down center of said gulch along Grant 2999 to Niau, the direct azimuth and distance being: 216° 00' 1636 feet;
11. Continuing down center of said gulch along said Grant 2999 to Niau, the direct azimuth and distance being 233° 10' 2151.0 feet to the point of beginning.
