Hanalei Homesteads, Halelea, Kauai:

Lot 4.

Beginning at the Northeast corner of this lot adjoining the Southeast corner of L.C.A. 4076 to Kamakaiwa on the West bank of the Hanalei River, the coordinates from Government Survey Trig. Station "Paina" being N. 17.0 feet and E. 777.4 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2262, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 20° 30' 500.5 feet along the West bank of the Hanalei River to the Northeast corner of Lot 6;
2. 72° 09' 130.8 feet along Lot 6 to Lot 5;
3. 208° 35' 37.8 feet along Lot 5;
4. 154° 33' 84.2 feet along Lot 5 to Lot 5 A;
5. 266° 42' 32.8 feet along Lot 5 A;
6. 206° 00' 163.7 feet along Lot 5 A;
7. 183° 57' 104.5 feet along Lot 5 A;
8. 190° 51' 190.1 feet along Lot 5 A;
9. 283° 27' 174.5 feet along Government Land and L.C.A. 4076 to Kamakaiwa to the initial point.
