Notes of Survey.

Commencing at the North East corner of this lot at a point marked by a post, the coordinates of which are 1168 ft. South and 12337 ft West from the H. G. S. Triangulation Station at the Opihilala Church, ~~the~~ ^{as} shown on Government Survey Registered Map Nos. 2068 and 2318, the Boundary runs thence by true meridian:

N 33° 40' W 295 feet along the mauka side of a 50 foot road to small Ohia tree branded I and II, 3 and 4,

N 47° 15' W 163 feet along a 40 foot road, thence,

S 70° 07' W 300 feet along said road, thence,

S 21° 10' W 113 feet along said road; thence,

S 64° 20' E 77 feet along said road, thence,

S 30° 57' E 145 feet along said road, thence,

S 16° 00' W 88 feet along said road, thence,

S 72° 37' E 226 feet along said road, thence,

N 59° 40' E 315 feet along lot 3 a to the Point of Commencement and containing an area of 4 1/4 Acres, a little more or less.

Note. In descriptions where tree is the corner mark it is because it was used in the original survey.

5. 115° 40' 97.0 feet along same to a pipe;
6. 213° 53' 140.8 feet along the Easterly side of a 40-foot road to a spike on pear tree;
7. 249° 50' 244.5 feet along same;
8. 291° 55' 35.0 feet along Southerly side of 40-foot road to a pipe;
9. 312° 45' 163.0 feet along South side of a road with a minimum width of 50 feet to a pipe;
10. 326° 20' 303.0 feet along same to a pipe;
11. 61° 21' 30" 315.6 feet along Lot 3-A to the point of beginning.
