Beginning at a stake at the Northwest corner of this lot, which is also the Southwest corner of Lot 4, the coordinates of said stake referred to Reference Point "Kalaepohaku" (marked by a + on a rock) on the boundary of Pulehunui and Waiakoa being 3192.6 feet South and 1213.5 feet East and said "Kalaepohaku" is 17875.5 feet North and 25734.0 feet West of Government Survey Trig. Station "Puu o Kali", as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2416 and running by true azimuths:-

1. 251° 18' 1879.4 feet along Lot 4;
2. 351° 56' 585.8 feet along 40 foot road;
3. 66° 33' 1799.0 feet along land of Kaonoulu;
4. 161° 18' 420.0 feet along beach reservation;
5. 162° 56' 165.6 feet along beach reservation;
6. 168° 10' 140.0 feet along beach reservation to the point of beginning.
