Beginning at a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe at the Southeast corner of this lot and the Northwest corner of Camp Road, and a 30 foot road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kalanial" being 8665.2 feet North and 1659.1 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2586, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $90^{\circ} 00'$ 495.5 feet along North side of Camp Road to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe at the top of East edge of Keahua Gulch;
2. $189^{\circ} 20'$ 330.6 feet along top of East edge of Keahua Gulch to + on rock;
3. $178^{\circ} 32'$ 650.5 feet along same;
4. $164^{\circ} 50'$ 120.0 feet along same;
5. $121^{\circ} 50'$ 228.2 feet along same;
6. $190^{\circ} 00'$ 159.1 feet along same;
7. $301^{\circ} 00'$ 1267.8 feet along Lot 4 to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
8. $31^{\circ} 00'$ 835.8 feet along Northwest side of 30 foot road to the point of beginning.
