Beginning at a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe at the Northwest corner of this lot and the Southwest corner of Lot 56, the coordinates of said pipe referred to the Government Survey Trig. Station "Puu-o-Nale" being: 8751.0 feet North and 5701.5 feet East, and the azimuth and distance to a similar $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe at Trig. Station "R" being $180^{\circ} 00' 45.0$ feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2579, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $270^{\circ} 00'$ 1165.4 feet along Lot 56 to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
2. $357^{\circ} 20'$ 580.6 feet along L. C. A. 8309 to Kekaka to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
3. $90^{\circ} 00'$ 1192.4 feet along Lot 54 to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
4. $180^{\circ} 00'$ 580.0 feet along Kaauhuhu Road to the point of beginning.

Area 15-70/100 Acres.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom, however, a right-of-way 15 feet wide for the Hawi Mill and Plantation Company's flume, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 15-55/100 ACRES.
