

Beginning at the East corner of this Lot and the South corner of Lot 57 and on the North side of a 20 feet road, the approximate coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "West Base" being 1577 feet North and 1640 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 1795, and running by true azimuths:-

1. Along the North side of a 20 foot road the direct azimuth and distance being: $73^{\circ} 46'$ 398.7 feet;
2. $149^{\circ} 07'$ 935.0 feet along Lot 55 to the middle of Waikelohua Gulch;
3. Thence along the middle of said Gulch to the West corner of Lot 57, the direct azimuth and distance being: $183^{\circ} 17'$ 890.0 feet;
4. $329^{\circ} 07'$ 1607.0 feet along Lot 57 to the point of beginning.

Lot # 56, Notes of Survey:-

Beginning at the North angle of Homestead

49 the boundary runs,

1. N. $73^{\circ} 46'$ E. "true" 398.7 feet along Lot # 48 to the East angle
the boundary however following
the windings of a road laid out
between the two lots.
2. N. $30^{\circ} 53'$ W. " 1628 feet along Lot # 57, to the North angle
in the continuation of the gully
called "awaua o Ka Pele" from
here on called Waikelehua gulch.
3. S. $3^{\circ} 17'$ W. " 690 feet the middle of the gulch the bound-
ary, to the West angle,
4. S. $30^{\circ} 53'$ E. " 956 feet along Lot # 55, to the Initial
Point.

Reserving however a strip 20 feet in width between Stations
I and 2.

Containing an area of 11.43 Acres.
