Beginning at a + on a stone at the Southwest corner of this lot and the Northwest corner of Lot 6, from which Government Survey Trig. Station "Nonou" is by true azimuth $75^{\circ} 15'$ and the Spire of the Native Church is by true azimuth $200^{\circ} 17'$, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2450, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $168^{\circ} 42'$ 107.7 feet along Rice and Kula Lot 1;
2. $186^{\circ} 11'$ 53.2 feet along bank of ditch;
3. $216^{\circ} 35'$ 140.8 feet along bank of ditch;
4. $248^{\circ} 43'$ 99.0 feet along bank of ditch;
5. $194^{\circ} 25'$ 120.9 feet along bank of ditch;
6. $268^{\circ} 25'$ 127.4 feet along Government kula land;
7. $3^{\circ} 44'$ 384.1 feet along Rice and Kula Lot 8;
8. $81^{\circ} 23'$ 296.4 feet along Rice and Kula Lot 6 to the point of beginning.
