Lot 5 A.

Beginning at the Southeast corner of this lot, the coordinates from Government Survey Trig. Station "Paina" being S. 380.3 feet and E. 493.0 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map, No. 2262, and running by true azimuths:-

1.  $86^{\circ} 42'$  32.8 feet along Lot 4 to North corner of Lot 5;
2.  $90^{\circ} 00'$  64.5 feet along Lot 5;
3.  $103^{\circ} 04'$  1170.2 feet along Lot 6 A to top of ridge;
4.  $231^{\circ} 35'$  240.3 feet along top of ridge and Government Land;
5.  $285^{\circ} 40'$  1141.9 feet along Lot 4 A;
6.  $26^{\circ} 00'$  115.2 feet along Lot 4 to the initial point.

Area 4-~~5~~10 Acres.

Reserving therefrom the right to thirty foot strip for roadway through said lot.
