Beginning at an iron rail at the West corner of this lot, the North corner of Lot 7 and on the South side of Mountain Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kauku" being ^{20098.3}~~20090.6~~ feet North and ^{7324.1}~~7334.8~~ feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. ^{2574,}~~2382~~, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 228° 30' 207.0 feet along Mountain Road to an iron rail;
2. 227° 00' 279.0 feet along Mountain Road to an iron rail;
3. 326° 56' 960.4 feet along Lot 5 to an iron rail;
4. 56° 55' 482.0 feet along Lot 12 to an iron rail;
5. 147° 05' 882.0 feet along Lot 7 to the point of beginning.

Area 10-15/100 Acres.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom a right-of-way 10 feet wide across this lot for the flume, said right-of-way containing an area of 11/100 acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 10-04/100 ACRES.
