10. Down center of Kapili Gulch along Grant 4178 to E. C. Steel and Lot 2, the direct azimuth and distance being:- 225° .00' 2540.0 feet to a  $\Delta$  marked on bedrock at top of falls;
11. 355° 30' 122.0 feet along road reserve;
12. 218° 14' 290.0 feet along road reserve to the point of beginning.
