Beginning at a 1 inch galvanized iron pipe at the South corner of this lot, the East corner of Lot 7, and on the North side of Lepoloa Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Honohina/^(Old)" being 1534.7 feet South and 4650.5 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2588, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 157° 45' 1444.6 feet along Lot 7 to a 1 inch galvanized iron pipe;
2. 243° 10' 70.0 feet along Grant 1539 to Pea to a 1 inch Galv. pipe;
3. 308° 51' 1012.0 feet along Government Main Road to a 1 inch galvanized iron pipe;
4. 313° 08' 72.3 feet along Government Main Road to a 1 inch galvanized iron pipe;
5. 324° 04' 80.6 feet along Government Main Road to a 1 inch galvanized iron pipe;
6. 330° 44' 420.5 feet along Government Main Road to a 1 inch galvanized iron pipe;
7. 67° 27' 659.9 feet along North side of Lepoloa Road to the point of beginning.
