Beginning at a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch pipe at the Southeast corner of this Lot and the Northeast corner of Lot 65, the coordinates of said pipe referred to the Government Survey Trig. Station "Puu-o-Nale" being: 5870.7 feet North and 4380.9 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2579, and running by true azimuths:-

1.  $90^{\circ} 00'$  1351.9 feet along Lot 65 to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch pipe;
2.  $182^{\circ} 25'$  567.3 feet along Government land of Kahei to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch pipe;
3.  $270^{\circ} 00'$  1388.4 feet along Lot 67 to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch pipe;
4.  $6^{\circ} 05'$  570.0 feet along Hawi Road to the point of beginning.
