Beginning at a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe at the E A S T corner of this lot, the S O U T H corner of Lot 7/8, and on the North side of the Kahuku-Piha 40 foot road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Haiku" being 6913.8 feet South and 3484.5 feet West as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2568, and running by true azimuths::

1. $68^{\circ} 00'$ 399.3 feet along the Kahuku-Piha 40 foot road;
2. $60^{\circ} 12'$ 266.1 feet along the Kahuku-Piha 40 foot road to a pipe;
3. $135^{\circ} 13'$ 910.9 feet along Lot 5 to a pipe on top of the South edge of Waikaumalo Gulch;
4. Thence along the top of the South edge of Waikaumalo Gulch to a pipe, the direct azimuth and distance being $219^{\circ} 30'$ 635.9 feet;
5. $315^{\circ} 34' 30''$ 1197.5 feet along Lot 7/8 to the point of beginning.

Area 14-12/100 Acres,

Excepting and Reserving therefrom a right-of-way 10 feet wide for the ditch across this lot; said right-of-way containing an area of 15/100 Acre; LEAVING A NET AREA OF 13-97/100 ACRES.

Also Excepting and Reserving therefrom the stream and all riparian and other rights in or to this stream and the waters thereof.
