Beginning at a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe at the Northeast corner of this Lot and the Southeast corner of Lot 70, the coordinates of said pipe referred to the Government Survey Trig. Station "Puu-o-Nale" being: 8097.7 feet North and 4539.5 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2579, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $358^{\circ} 54'$ 591.2 feet along Hawi Road to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
2. $90^{\circ} 00'$ 1452.8 feet along Lot 68 to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
3. $182^{\circ} 25'$ 591.6 feet along Government land of Kahei to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
4. $270^{\circ} 00'$ 1416.5 feet along Lot 70 to the point of beginning.

Area $19-46/100$ Acres.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom a right-of-way 40 feet wide for the Kohala Ditch Company's ditch, said right-of-way extending 20 feet either side from the center line of the ditch, LEAVING A NET AREA OF $17-36/100$ ACRES.
