9. 211° 58' 91.5 feet along the road to a + on stone;
10. 182° 08' 92.9 feet along the road to a + on stone;
11. 255° 52' 113.6 feet along the road and across gulch to a + on stone;
12. 359° 02' 243.9 feet along the road to a + on stone;

13. 300° 37' 404.7 feet along the road to a + on stone;

14. 21° 07' 351.5 feet along Lot 70 to the point of beginning.
