Beginning at a \star on rock set in ground at the North corner of this lot and the West corner of Lot 6 and on the South side of Kula Government 80 foot road, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Puu Kahala" being 7882.7 feet South and 18104.3 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2239, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $307^{\circ} 48'$ 1200.0 feet along Lot 6 to \star on rock set in ground at the Northwest corner of Grant 626 to E. S. Ruggles;
2. $16^{\circ} 00'$ 140.5 feet along Grant 626 to E. S. Ruggles to a + on rock set in ground;
3. $14^{\circ} 55'$ 621.0 feet along Lot 5 to a + on solid rock on boundary between the lands of Alae 1 & 2 and Alae 3 & 4; the true azimuth to Waiakea Catholic Church Spire being $179^{\circ} 49'$; Puu o Kali Trig. Station $75^{\circ} 10'$; Puu o Koha Trig. Station $153^{\circ} 11'$
4. $130^{\circ} 41'$ 1439.0 feet along the land of Alae 1 & 2 to \star on rock on South side of Kula Government Road;
5. $170^{\circ} 00'$ 248.5 feet along South side of Kula Government Road;
6. $233^{\circ} 12'$ 480.0 feet along South side of Kula Government Road to the point of beginning.
