Beginning at a mamane post at the North corner of this lot and the West corner of Lot 6 on the East side of the Waiohuli road, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Puu-o-Kali" being: 5859.8 feet South and 17569.8 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2494, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 309° 46' 1856.0 feet along Lot 6 to a mamane post on the boundary of the mauka pasture lands;
2. 39° 46' 700.0 feet along the mauka pasture lands to a mamane post;
3. 129° 46' 2009.0 feet along Lot 8 to a mamane post on the East side of the Waiohuli road;
4. 264° 21' 156.2 feet along the Waiohuli road to a mamane post;
5. 224° 01' 590.0 feet along the Waiohuli road to the point of beginning.
