Lot VII.

Notes of Survey.

Comencing at the West corner of this lot at a point on the East side of a 40 foot road, being also the South corner of Lot VI marked by an Ohia tree branded VI and VII, the coordinates of which are 2654 ft. South and 12058 ft. West from H. G. S. Triangulation Station at the Opihilala Church, the Boundary runs thence by true meridian,

1- N 36° 03' E 625 feet along lot VI, thence;


2- S 78° 30' E 2295 feet along the Mauka side of Government Reserve, thence,

3- S 08° 35' W 1205 feet up along middle of great Gulch to a point marked by Kukui tree which is also the North East corner of lot VIII, thence,

4- N 80° 57' W 2550 feet along Makai Boundary of lot VIII to the East side of a 40 foot road, thence,

5- N 06° 00' E 743 feet along said road to the Point of Commencement and containing an area of 72 1/2 Acres, a little more or less.

Note. In descriptions where tree is the corner mark it is because it was used in the original survey.
