Beginning at a square stone set in the ground on side of hill (marked on top with a + and the east side MCB) at the ~~South~~ East corner of this lot and the Northeast corner of Lot 75 on the boundary of Lawai, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Papapaholahola" are 5238.6 feet South and 4065.2 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2378, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 65° 40' 1127.4 feet along Lot 75 to a + on stone;
2. 162° 23' 37.0 feet along the road to a + on stone;
3. 171° 07' 343.2 feet along the road to a + on stone;
4. 188° 03' 192.9 feet along the road to a + on stone;
5. 190° 04' 472.4 feet along the road to a + on stone;
6. 292° 00' 892.0 feet along Lot 73 to a + on large square stone;
7. 326° 14' 279.1 feet along the land of Lawai to the point of beginning.

Area 14-52/100 Acres.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom a right-of-way 60 feet wide across this lot for the Kauai Electric Co.'s Transmission Line.
