Beginning at a 2 inch galvanized iron pipe at the Northwest corner of this lot, the Northeast corner of Lot 6 and on the South side of a 40 foot road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Alala" being 1884.9 feet South and 3089.4 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2497, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 259° 39' 1019.2 feet along road to a 2 inch galvanized iron pipe;
2. 334° 50' 215.0 feet along the Government Road to the Northeast corner of the Catholic Church lot;
3. 64° 50' 296.6 feet along the Catholic Church lot to a 2 inch galvanized iron pipe;
4. 334° 50' 466.9 feet along the Catholic Church lot to a 2 inch galvanized iron pipe;
5. Westerly along the top of the pali near the edge of the Waiaama Gulch, the direct azimuth and distance being ~~89° 12'~~ <sup>90° 48'</sup> 1024.2 feet;
6. 180° 00' 545.8 feet along Lot 6 to the point of beginning.

Area 14-06/100 Acres.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 15 feet wide across this lot for the flume.
