North Hilo, Hawaii.

Beginning at a 1 inch galvanized iron pipe at the East corner of this lot, the South corner of Lot 6 and on the North side of Lepoloo Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Honohina/<sup>(Old)</sup>" being 1534.7 feet South and 4650.5 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2588, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 67° 27' 208.9 feet along North side of Lepoloo Road to a 1 inch galvanized iron pipe;
2. 67°44'30" 291.7 feet along North side of Lepoloo Road to a 1 inch galvanized iron pipe;
3. 157° 45' 1485.6 feet along Lot 8 to a 1 inch galvanized iron pipe;
4. 257° 39' 318.1 feet along Grant 1539 to Pea to a 1 inch galvanized iron pipe;
5. 243° 10' 187.1 feet along Grant 1539 to Pea to a 1 inch galvanized iron pipe;
6. 337° 45' 1444.6 feet along Lot 6 to the point of beginning.

Area 16-64/100 Acres.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom a right of way 10 feet wide for the ditch across this lot, said right-of-way containing an area of 0.07 acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 16-57/100 ACRES.
