Beginning at the East corner of this lot at a point adjoining Lepoloa ~~Homesteads~~, the coordinates of which point being: 3596.8 feet South and 1552.7 feet West of the Government Survey Trig. Station "Honohina", as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2381, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 56° 12' 1096.5 feet along Lepoloa, ~~Homesteads~~;
2. 47° 17' 1735.0 feet along Lepoloa ~~Homesteads to post~~ to ditch;
3. Along makai *bank* of said ditch, the direct azimuth and distance being: 196° 30' 760.0 feet;
4. Continuing along makai **bank** of said ditch, the direct azimuth and distance being: 136° 12' 339.0 feet;
5. 197° 24' 132.0 feet along road reserve;
6. 256° 30' 437.5 feet along road reserve;
7. 228° 13' 1384.0 feet along road reserve to cross road;
8. 306° 30' 145.0 feet along cross road reserve;
9. 265° 50' 418.0 feet along cross road reserve to the center of **Awapuhi Stream**;
10. 329° 07' 329.0 feet along Lot 6 to the point of beginning.
