Revised Description.

Lot 77.

Manowaiopae Homesteads,
North Hilo, Hawaii.

Beginning at a $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe at the East corner of this lot, one of the Western angles of Lot 76, and on the East side of a 30 foot Homestead Road, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Manowaiopae 3" being 5236.1 feet South and 6527.6 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2555, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $55^{\circ} 56'$ 408.7 feet along near West edge of Kilau Gulch;
2. $80^{\circ} 55'$ 220.0 feet along near West edge of Kilau Gulch;
3. $25^{\circ} 10'$ 170.0 feet along near West edge of Kilau Gulch;
4. $33^{\circ} 10'$ 220.0 feet along near West edge of Kilau Gulch;
5. $342^{\circ} 20'$ 188.0 feet along near West edge of Kilau Gulch;
6. $16^{\circ} 30'$ 220.0 feet along near West edge of Kilau Gulch;
7. $34^{\circ} 00'$ 250.0 feet along near West edge of Kilau Gulch to a $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe;
8. $156^{\circ} 45'$ 560.0 feet along Lot 3 of the Laupahoehoe Homesteads;
9. $197^{\circ} 47'$ 370.0 feet along near East edge of Puu Alaea Gulch;
10. $174^{\circ} 51'$ 178.7 feet along near East edge of Puu Alaea Gulch;

11. 239° 20' 717.9 feet along near East edge of Puu Alaea Gulch to a
2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;

12. 297° 55' 452.9 feet along Lot 76 to the point of beginning.

Area 13-30/100 Acres.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom a right-of-way 15 feet wide
for a proposed flume over this lot, which said flume will be parallel
to the West boundary of said lot, (area 44/100 acre); LEAVING A NET AREA
OF 12-86/100 ACRES.
