Beginning at a marked stone post (8" x 8" with a + on top and MCB cut in on the East side) at the Northeast corner of this lot, the Southeast corner of Lot 76 and on the boundary of Lawai at a point called Haleana, the coordinates of which referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Papapaholahola" are 6252.7 feet South and 4523.8 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2378, and running by true azimuths:-

5. 335° 40' 66.0 feet along L.C.A. 6647:1 to Una ;
6. 291° 40' 178.0 feet along L.C.A. 6647:1 to Una to a + on stone;
7. 23° 15' 261.7 feet along 20 foot right-of-way to a + on stone;
8. 113° 09' 226.6 feet along government road to a + on stone;
9. 142° 55' 90.7 feet along government road to a + on stone;
10. 178° 09' 193.2 feet along government road to a + on stone;
11. 161° 05' 183.3 feet along government road to a . on stone;

- 12. 229° 10' 351.8 feet along Lot 76 to a + on stone;
- 13. 253° 00' 620.6 feet along Lot 76 to the point of beginning.
