Down the middle of Puuokalepa Stream, the direct azimuths and distances being:

1. 214° 10' 260.0 feet;
2. 281° 40' 544.0 feet;
3. 225° 09' 961.5 feet to a red-wood post;
4. 313° 15' 40.0 feet along homestead road to a red-wood post;
5. 346° 22' 109.0 feet along homestead road to a red-wood post;
6. 303° 00' 217.9 feet along homestead road to a red-wood post;
7. 269° 30' 167.7 feet along homestead road to a red-wood post;
8. 63° 26' 1568.9 feet along homestead road ^{and} along Lot 11 to a pipe;
9. 115° 00' 400.0 feet along Lot 11 to the point of beginning.
