Beginning at a 1 inch galvanised iron pipe at the South corner of this lot, the East corner of Lot 9, and on the North side of Lepoloa Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Honohina/^(Old)" being 1908.9 feet South and 3739.2 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2588 and running by true azimuths:-

1. 157° 45' 1372.4 feet along Lot 9 to a 1 inch galvanized iron pipe;
2. 234° 38' 498.5 feet along Grant 1539 to Pea to a 1 inch galvanized iron pipe;
3. 337° 45' 1485.6 feet along Lot 7 to a 1 inch galvanized iron pipe;
4. 67° 44' 30" 485.5 feet along the North side of Lepoloa Road to the point of beginning.

Area 15-94/100 Acres.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 10 feet wide for the ditch across this lot, said right of way containing an area of 0.21 acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 15-73/100 ACRES.
