Beginning at the Northwest corner of this lot and the Northeast corner of Lot 7, Honokaa Section, the true azimuth and distance from the Southwest corner of Lot 18C, Honokaa Section, (Grant 4924 to J. Correia) being: $15^{\circ} 16' 78.0$ feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 1878, and running by true azimuths:-

1. Along the South side of 50 foot road, the direct azimuth and distance being: $235^{\circ} 04' 307.2$ feet;
2. $15^{\circ} 16'$ 3180.0 feet along Lot 8, Honokaa Section, (Grant 4717 to Mattias Batista);
3. $94^{\circ} 55'$ 200.0 feet along Government land;
4. $195^{\circ} 16'$ 2980.0 feet along Lot 7, Honokaa Section, to the point of beginning.
