Beginning at a post marked IX-X at the East corner of this lot and road reserve, the coordinates of which point are 5276.1 feet South and 9505.7 feet West of Government Survey Trig. Station "Papaa-  
lea", as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2256, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 28° 30' 913.0 feet along 50 foot road reserve to a post;
2. 118° 30' 924.0 feet along Government land to a post marked IX on the East bank of Kilau Gulch;
3. Along the East bank of Kilau Gulch, the direct azimuth and distance being: 211° 28' 914.5 feet to a post marked IX-X on the bank of gulch;
4. 298° 30' 876.7 feet along Lot 10 to the point of beginning.

Area 21-17/100 Acres.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom a strip of land 50 feet wide across this lot for a public road, said road strip containing an area of 63/100 acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 20-54/100 ACRES.
