Beginning at a 1 inch galvanized iron pipe at the East corner of this lot, the South corner of Lot 8, and on the North side of Lepoloa Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Honohina"^(Old) being 1908.9 feet South and 3739.2 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2588, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 67° 44' 30" 588.5 feet along North side of Lepoloa Road to a 1 inch galvanized iron pipe;
2. 157° 45' 1312.7 feet along Lot 10 to a 1 inch galvanized iron pipe;
3. 247° 48' 330.6 feet along Grant 1539 to Pea to a 1 inch galvanized iron pipe;
4. 234° 38' 264.8 feet along Grant 1539 to Pea to a 1 inch galvanized iron pipe;
5. 337° 45' 1372.4 feet along Lot 8 to the point of beginning.

Area 17-91/100 Acres.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 10 feet wide for the ditch across this lot, said right-of-way containing an area of 0.07 acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 17-84/100 ACRES.
