Revised Description.

Lot 96

Manowaiopae Homesteads,
North Hilo, Hawaii.

Beginning at a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe at the North corner of this lot, the West corner of Lot 97, and on the East side of a 30 foot Homestead Road, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Manowaiopae 3" being 3617.2 feet South and 8657.4 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2555, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 298° 35' 1913.2 feet along Lot 97 to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
2. 10° 41' 100.0 feet along near West edge of Puu Alaea Gulch;
3. 26° 18' 257.0 feet along near West edge of Puu Alaea Gulch to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
4. 118° 35' 2016.9 feet along Lots 94 and 95 to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
5. 213° 16' 236.2 feet along East side of Homestead Road;
6. 223° 13' 81.7 feet along East side of Homestead Road;
7. 239° 28' 44.0 feet along East side of Homestead Road to the point of beginning.

Area 16-30/100 Acres

Excepting and Reserving therefrom a right-of-way 15 feet wide for a proposed flume over this lot, which said lot will be parallel to the East boundary of said lot (area 12/100 acre); LEAVING A NET AREA OF 16-18/100 ACRES.
