Revised Description.

Lot 97.

Manowaiopae Homesteads,
North Hilo, Hawaii.

Beginning at a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe at the West corner of this lot, the North corner of Lot 96, and on the East side of a 30 foot Homestead Road, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Manowaiopae 3" being 3617.2 feet South and 8657.4 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2555, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 239° 28' 103.4 feet along East side of Homestead Road;
2. 217° 40' 204.5 feet along East side of Homestead Road;
3. 264° 06' 121.4 feet along South side of Homestead Road to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
4. 299° 15' 2037.6 feet along Lot 98 to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
5. 68° 43' 159.4 feet along near North edge of Puu Alaea Gulch;
6. 82° 43' 276.2 feet along near North edge of Puu Alaea Gulch;
7. 10° 41' 55.0 feet along near West edge of Puu Alaea Gulch;
8. 118° 35' 1913.2 feet along Lot 96 to the point of beginning.

Area 15-88/100 Acres.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom a right-of-way 15 feet wide for a proposed flume over this lot, which said flume will be parallel to the Southeast boundary of said lot, (area 15/100 acre); LEAVING A NET AREA OF 15-73/100 ACRES.
